# **BC Descriptors at the end of Key Stage 1**

BC Descriptors for Key Stage 1 refer to the basic competency that students have to attain by Primary 3. Below are the BC Descriptors for different papers. Students should be aware of whether they attain these competency.

### Listening

- Using a small range of strategies to understand the meaning of simple texts on familiar topics which are delivered slowly and clearly in familiar accents. (IS, **KS**, ES)
- Discriminating between common words with a small range of vowel and consonant sounds. (KS)

## **Reading and Writing**

### Reading

• Using a small range of reading strategies to understand the meaning of simple texts with the help of cues. (IS, **KS**, ES)

### Writing

- Writing simple texts using a small range of vocabulary, sentence patterns, cohesive devices and verb forms fairly appropriately with the help of cues despite some spelling and grammatical mistakes. (IS, **KS**, ES)
- Writing and / or responding to simple texts with relevant information and ideas (including personal experiences, imaginative ideas and evaluative remarks) with the help of cues. (**IS**, **KS**, **ES**)

## Speaking

### Part 1: Spontaneous language use in given situations

• Using formulaic expressions to establish and maintain routines and relationships in school contexts with the help of cues. (IS)

### Part 2: Reading aloud

• Showing a basic understanding of short, simple and familiar texts by reading aloud the texts clearly and comprehensibly. (**KS**, ES)

### **Part 3: Picture descriptions**

- Pronouncing simple and familiar words comprehensibly. (KS)
- Providing short answers to short and simple questions. (IS, **KS**, ES)

### **Part 4: Expression of personal experiences**

• Providing short answers to short and simple questions. (IS, KS, ES)

# **Exam Strategies**

Bear these strategies in mind before the examination:

- 1. Take sufficient practices before the exams, so as to familiarize yourself with the exam format and duration of each paper.
- 2. Be on time to the examination venue. Bring appropriate and sufficient stationery, such as pencils and rubbers for the exams.
- 3. Remember to write down your school code, class and class number at the bottom of the first page of the exam paper.
- 4. Below are some essential strategies for each paper:

Paper	Strategies
Listening	<ul> <li>Listen carefully to the recording, tick the best answer when you hear the beep.</li> <li>Pay particular attention to words with similar pronunciation, such as 'thirteen' and 'thirty'. The recording may contain lots of these words.</li> <li>At Key Stage 1, the recording will usually be played twice. Don't panic even if you cannot get the answers in the first time.</li> <li>Make good use of the time for music and pauses to check your answers. Don't spend too much time on the same question.</li> <li>If there is some vocabulary that you don't know its meanings, try to guess them by looking at the pictures. They may provide you with many hints. Students at Key Stage 1 should be able to identify key words and main ideas when provided with cues.</li> </ul>
Reading and Writing	<ul><li>Reading</li><li>Read the texts and pictures carefully. If there is some vocabulary that you don't</li></ul>
writing	<ul> <li>Read the texts and pictures calefully. If there is some vocabulary that you don't know its meanings, try to guess them by looking at the pictures. They may provide you with many hints. Students at this level should be able to identify key words and the main idea in a sentence.</li> <li>The duration for this paper is very tight, don't spend too much time on the same question. About 10 seconds for each question is recommended.</li> <li>Don't tick more than one answer for the multiple-choice questions unless you are asked to do so, because marks would be deducted.</li> </ul>

## **Reading and Writing**

1. Sometimes the wordings in the question may not be the same as that in the reading text. Think about the meaning twice and tick the correct answer.

For example:

'Washing up' relates to dishes and bowls, it has nothing to do with 'tidy' nor 'sweep', so the answer is A.

2. Sometimes the options given may be confusing. Read both the text and questions carefully and get their main ideas.

For example:

He saw Little Tortoise, who was unhappy. 'Mum and dad are working,' said Little Tortoise. ' <b>No one plays with me</b> .'	<ul> <li>Why was Little Tortoise unhappy?</li> <li>A. The last sentence of the extract reveals that Little Tortoise was unhappy because no one plays with him, so the answer is C.
