Sick Leave

The parent of the student must inform the office of the student's absence 5 due to sickness from 7:45 to 8:00 a.m. on any school day. A letter written by the parent and a medical certificate should be submitted to the form teacher on the next school day.

If a student is absent from school due to sickness in the examination period, she must follow the proper procedures for applying for sick leave.

10 Otherwise, the supplementary examination will not be arranged.

Please note the following:

- A medical certificate refers to the certificate issued by a qualified Western doctor.
- Chinese herbal prescriptions and letters by Chinese bone-setters are not accepted.
 - Absence will be considered as truancy and a minor demerit will be given if any student fails to comply with the regulations above.



thus he stopped to take a rest. He'll catch

up / catch up with us later.'



2. Hold up

Meaning: raise / lift to a higher-than-normal position

Example: Cathy won the champion in the distance running competition. She proudly **held** her

trophy **up** for all to see.



3. Look down on

eaning: regard as inferior

Example: Jonathan only has a few friends. He

always looks down on anyone who is not

as rich as him.



4. Look up to

Meaning: respect

Example: All students look up to Miss Chan

because she is the guest speaker of today's

talk.
